NOTE ABOUT PHOTOGRAPHS

St Callan's Churchyard has been visited by Christine Stokes at least seven or eight times. On each occasion photographs have been taken. Finding each stone in this burial ground is an absolute nightmare. It is true to say that with the exception of Clyne Kirkton before the clean up there St Callan's is the most damaged of all Sutherland Burial Grounds. Many of the stones here are broken or fallen (including my own ancestors), many are below the turf and many of those still standing are fast becoming illegible. Thus you will find many missing photographs. I will try again this year but not certain I will find more standing stones. At the end of RO-B part two photograph album I have shown some damaged stones to describe the situation.

In loving memory of William MURRAY, eldest son of Paul and Jane MURRAY, The Bank, Rogart, died 31st December 1898, aged 28 years; also Jane ROSS, wife of the above Paul MURRAY, died 6th March 1919, aged 70 years; the above Paul MURRAY, died 31st March 1924, aged 77; also their son Donald, died 18 March 1934, aged 53.

RO-B2A

Erected by Isabella ROSS in memory of her beloved husband Alexander MURRAY who died at Bank, Rogart, 2nd February 1943 aged 70 years. Also their son William John who died 28th May 1926 aged 13 years and the above Isabella ROSS died 30th October 1967 aged 82 years.

RO-B3

In memory of Alexandrina MACKENZIE, beloved wife of Duncan MACPHERSON, who died at Culdrain 5 Oct 1908, aged 66; the said Duncan MACPHERSON, who died at Corriemony, 6 July 1920, aged 96; their son Andrew, died at Dunrobin Glen, 4 August 1885, aged 15; their daughter Annie, died at Perth 4 March 1939. Erected by the Family

Christina MACKENZIE, sister of Alexina, died Craggie, Rogart, 26 February 1900. (not on photo)

RO-B4

Allan MACKENZIE, Ardighoner, Rogart, died 12 January 1885; wife Alexa SUTHERLAND, died 18 March 1898, aged 69; children died infants.

RO-B5

Sacred to the memory of Annie DAVIDSON, Inchcape, who died 18 November 1889, aged 46 years. Gone but not forgotten.

A.C. E.J. CAMERON, died 23 December 1825 aged 3 months 10 days.

Andrew SUTHERLAND, Pittentrail, Rogart and his wife Mary MACKAY. This gravestone is now difficult to read. However we do know that Mary Mackay died around 1836.

Isabella, 5th daughter of Andrew SUTHERLAND, late merchant, Pittentrail, Rogart, died 15 November 1824, aged 24, stone erected by mother Mary MACKAY on 28 December 1831.

Christian SUTHERLAND, died 3 March 1821, aged 27 years, stone erected by her parents, Andrew SUTHERLAND and Mary MACKAY.

RO-B29

This stone is placed here in the memory of John SUTHERLAND, tenant in Claggin, Rogart, died 6 December 1845, aged 94 years, a church elder for 50 years; his wife, Elspet ROSS, died 9 February 1829, aged 76 years; their eldest son Andrew SUTHERLAND, died April 1804, aged 29 years, stone erected by son James SUTHERLAND.

RO-B30 (no photo)

William SUTHERLAND of the 93rd Regiment, Muie, Rogart, died April 1878, aged 96 years; his wife Hannah SULLIVAN, died 28 January 1880, aged 78 years; their daughters Marion SUTHERLAND, died 28 July 1897, aged 64 years; Mary SUTHERLAND, died 9 March 1900, aged 81 years; their son, Daniel SUTHERLAND, schoolmaster in Rogart, died East Clyne, 21 February 1913, aged 84. On the reverse of this fallen, worn, stone is a further inscription to a SUTHERLAND of Craggy, Rogart, and his wife Merran possibly GRAHAM – no dates

John SUTHERLAND, died 29 July 1856, aged 43 years; his wife, Ann MACLEOD, Culdrain, Rogart, died 26 December 1890, aged 57 years; their daughter, Christina SUTHERLAND, died 5 July 1867, aged 11 years. Stone erected in 1864.

Niel SUTHERLAND, Inchcape, Rogart, died 19 June 1877; his wife, Euphemia MACKAY, died 13 November 1921, aged 96 years; their son, Donald SUTHERLAND, died 5 August 1945, aged 78 years; Donald's wife, Jessie ROSS, died 18 February 1968, aged 87 years.

Alexander BANNERMAN, Justice of the Peace, died 9 August 1912, aged 91 years; his wife Sarah GUNN, died 13 September 1904, aged 79; their children, Christina BANNERMAN, died 27 September 1882, aged 13 years; Alexander BANNERMAN, farmer, died 27 October 1945, aged 79 years; Alexander junior's wife, Christina M. ROSS, died Tain, Ross & Cromarty 23 April 1935, aged 63 years; Ian BANNERMAN, son of Alexander junior and Christina Ross, died Australia 5 March 1932, aged 32.

Hugh MACKAY, lotter, died 20 February 1870, aged 81; his wife Catherine MACKENZIE, Ardchue, Rogart, died May 1839, aged 52 years; their daughter Betsy MACKAY, died 24 May 1876, aged 58 years. Stone erected by daughter Margaret MACKAY.

Peter LAWSON, Davochbeg, Chief Inspector Sutherland County Roads, died 28 October 1837, aged 58 years; stone erected by his widow May BAYNE and his brother James LAWSON.

Erected to the memory of Georgina GILLESPIE, daughter of Joseph GILLESPIE, Braegrudy, died 7 April 1845 aged 21 years.

RO-B42

In remembrance of Christina MACKENZIE who died on the 17 day of January 1887, aged 44 years

Erected in memory of Janet SUTHERLAND, the beloved wife of Hugh SUTHERLAND, Culdrain, who died on the 5th day of February 1844, aged 38 years; also of their son John SUTHERLAND, who died on the 29th day of May 1853, aged 23 years.

RO-B47

Captain John MACKAY, tacksman, Pitfure, Rogart, died 7 June 1840, aged 69 years; also in memory of George MACKAY, eldest son of said Captain MACKAY, departed this life in the Island of Trinidad, 17 November 1838, age 24 years; of Andrew MACKAY, his second son, who died in the Island of Trinidad Aug 16th 1843, aged 25 years; and of John MACKAY, his fourth son, who died in Melbourne, Australia, 18 January 1853, aged 30 years. Also to the memory of Elizabeth SUTHERLAND his spouse, departed this life at Pitfure on the 26th December 1868, aged 79 years.

RO-B48

George GORDON, Gaelic teacher about 33 years, died 6 December 1849, aged 67 years; his daughter Janet GORDON, died 29 October 1850, age 17 years. Stone erected by widow of George Gordon, Morness, Rogart

Erected in loving memory of Angus MACKAY, who died at Torbreck on 9 Octr 1866; and his wife Helen MACDONALD, who died at Tannachy on 14th June 1906; and their sons John, who died at Tannachy on 9th June 1911, and Angus on 7th June 1928, and William, who died at Spinningdale, [Creich] on 27th October 1932.

RO-B51

John MACKAY, Pitfour, Rogart, died 17 August 1899, aged 78 years; his wife Marion MURRAY, died 8 January 1902, aged 86 years; their daughter Margaret MACKAY, died 31 March 1906, aged 51 years; son William MACKAY, died 10 September 1919, aged 82 years.

RO-B52

Sacred to the memory of Donald Gordon, farmer of Cluranich, who died 2nd February 1851, aged 84 years; this stone is erected over the remains of his regretted family; also his wife Christina MACKAY, died 9 July 1872, aged 86 years.

Henrietta GORDON, died 11 September 1878, aged 65 years; stone erected by her husband John MACDONALD, Cluranich, Rogart; and their sons. On the reverse side of stone: J. GORDON.

Sacred to the memory of Andrew MURRAY, shepherd Blarich, who died on the 23rd January 1854, aged 66 years; also of Robert MURRAY, his son, who died 2 Oct 1849, aged 27 years.

Erected by Andrew MURRAY in sacred memory of his beloved spouse Isabella AITKEN, who departed this life May 1st 1835 in the 52nd year of her age.

RO-B56

Erected by a few friends to the memory of Alexander FORBES, elder in the Free Church of this parish, who departed this life on the 24 June 1866, aged 60 years; in the discharge of his duty he was faithful affectionate and earnest and his Christian profession was such as to cause him to be respected by his neighbours and loved by those who knew him best; also Catherine MATHESON, his wife, died 17 December 1863, aged 79 years. [date obscured by grass in photo]

RO-B57

Sacred to the memory of David MURRAY, late Ground Officer, Rogart, who departed this life at Splock Hill Cottage in June 1826, aged 43 years.
